Usted **no** tiene que realizar sus servicios comunitarios en uno de los sitios en la lista, sin embargo, si usted decide escoger a una organización que no está en la lista, usted **debe** proveer pruebas a la corte que la organización es sin fines de lucro. La organización puede proveerle la documentación necesaria.

Para poder recibir crédito por su servicio, debe comprobar en escrito con una carta de la organización con el logotipo o sello y la siguiente información:

- Las fechas cuando el servicio fue realizado
- Las horas realizadas
- Tipo de trabajo que fue realizado (limpieza, archivar, etc.)
- Nombre, titulo, y número para contactar al supervisor en la organización

Por favor mantenga una copia de la carta para su propio registro. La carta original debe ser sometida a la corte. Tome nota que la corte puede llamar y verificar la información de la carta. *Si no realiza sus servicios comunitarios puede resultar en que una petición sea presentada para revocar su supervisión, descargo condicional o probatoria. Usted puede enfrentar tiempo en la cárcel.*

**Trabajar para un negocio y recibir pago NO cumple con los requisitos para su trabajo de servicio público. Usted no debe de recibir compensación por cualquier trabajo o servicio. Trabajo de servicio público NO será aceptado si es realizado en línea (internet).**

Cada organización reserva el derecho de excluir ciertas ofensas y la edad mínima y/o el proceso de selección. Si a usted se le niega la oportunidad de realizar su servicio público en alguna organización, es su responsabilidad de comprobar a la corte de la negación. Esto no lo excusa de completar sus horas de servicio público- contacte a otra organización!
