PARENTING-TIME SUPERVISOR ORDER AT REDUCED RATE

Cause comes on for entry of an Order supplementing the Parenting-Time Supervisor ("Supervisor") appointment Order entered separately this date; being fully advised in the premises, the Court HEREBY FINDS and IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The Court finds that the Plaintiff is indigent as defined in 735 ILCS 5/5-105(a)(2) and therefore Plaintiff's fees and costs for the Supervisor are ____% waived. Plaintiff shall pay ____% of the Supervisor's fees and costs. This determination is subject to annual review or sooner as the Court may order upon a substantial change in Plaintiff's financial circumstances.
2. The Court finds that the Defendant is indigent as defined in 735 ILCS 5/5-105(a)(2) and therefore Defendant's fees and costs for the Supervisor are ____% waived. Defendant shall pay ____% of the Supervisor's fees and costs. This determination is subject to annual review or sooner as the Court may order upon a substantial change in Defendant's financial circumstances.
3. _____ is appointed Supervisor on a reduced-rate basis of \$_____/hour subject to available funds as allocated to the Will County Domestic Relations Division for the fiscal year 20____. No Retainer is ordered as fees will be paid periodically as set forth herein below. The Clerk shall send a copy of the Affidavit of Acceptance No. 153 and this Order to the Will County Assistant Trial Court Administrator.
4. The Supervisor shall abide by the conditions and frequency for supervised parenting-time as set forth in the separate Order entered this date and in any future subsequent Orders modifying the same.
5. On each court date hereafter, subject to the conditions set forth herein, hearing shall be held regarding approval of the Supervisor's fees.

6. The Supervisor shall on the ____ day of each month file in the court case detailed monthly billing statements for review and approval by the Court. Copies of the same shall be sent to all parties of record. The parties shall thereafter have five (5) days to file any objections to the billing and provide notice of the same to the Supervisor. Time is of the essence with regards to the submission of the billing statements. Failure to submit billing statements timely **shall** result in the automatic forfeiture of the Supervisor's right to seek payment for each monthly billing cycle missed. The Supervisor's presence is waived at the time of hearing so long as no one has filed an objection within five (5) days of receipt of the billing. Any objections not timely filed will be deemed waived.

7. Hearing on the Supervisor's interim fees is set for _____, 20____ at _____
[Date to be set no later than two (2) weeks after the date of submission]. Upon entry of the Order approving reasonable fees and costs, the Clerk shall send a copy of the Order to the Will County Trial Court Administrator who will process the Order for payment.
