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The Application for Waiver of Criminal Court Assessments is granted, effective on the date the Application was first filed. The court finds (check one): 75% of all assessments are waived. The applicant must pay 25% of all assessments because the applicant's available income is more than 200% but not greater than 250% of the current povert level; or 50% of all assessments are waived. The applicant must pay 50% of all assessments because the applicant's available income is more than 250% but not greater than 300% of the current povert level; or 25% of all assessments are waived. The applicant must pay 75% of all assessments because the applicant's available income is more than 300% but not greater than 400% of the current povert level. Income findings are based on the current poverty level as established by the U.S. Dept. of Health & Human Services, and the applicant's non-exempt assets under 735 ILCS 5/12-901 and 735 ILCS 5/12-1001 are such that the applicant is unable to pay the assessments.
